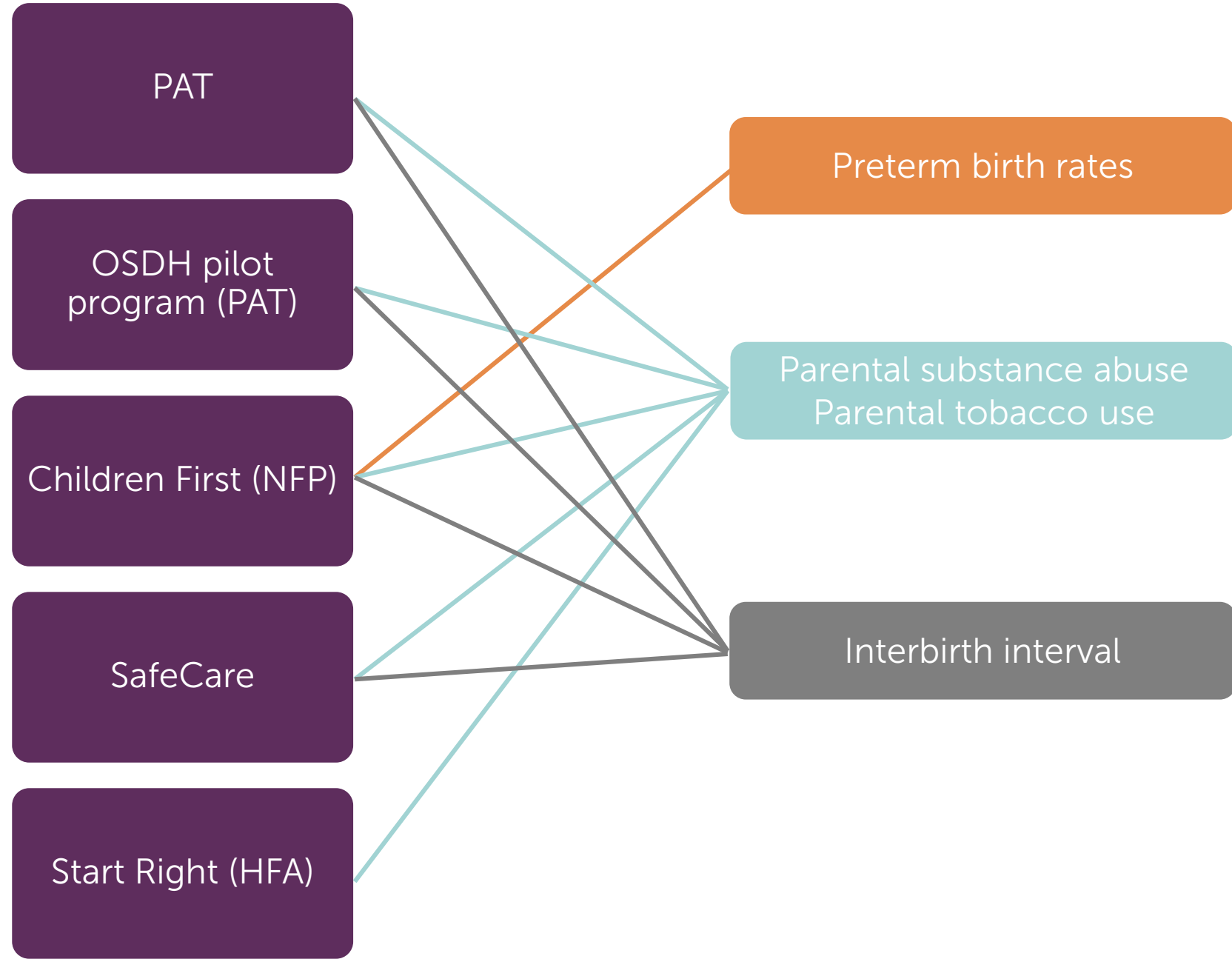


6 Home Visiting Priorities

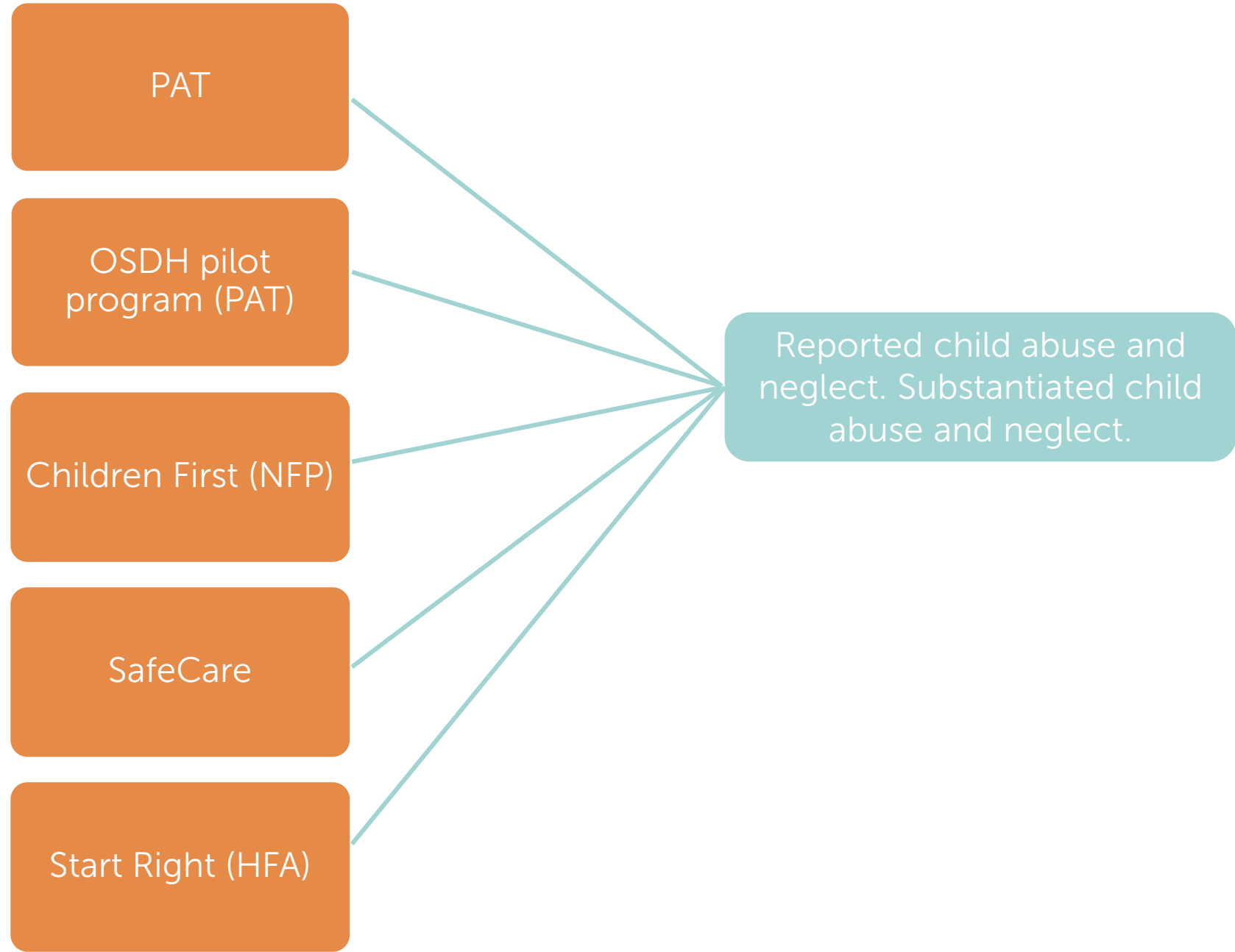
To strengthen the effectiveness and accountability of the state's home visiting system:

- Improve children's social-emotional, cognitive, language, and physical development.

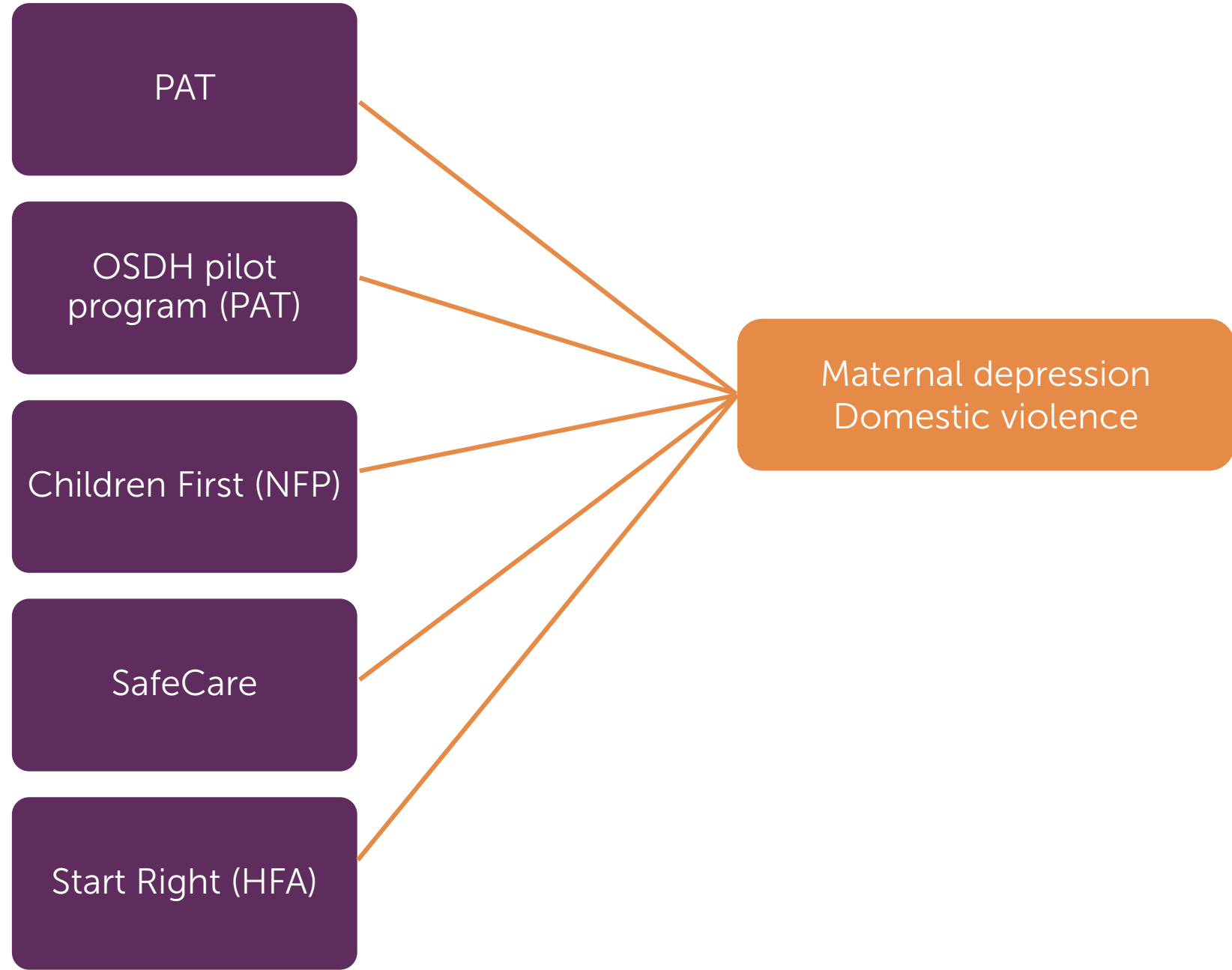

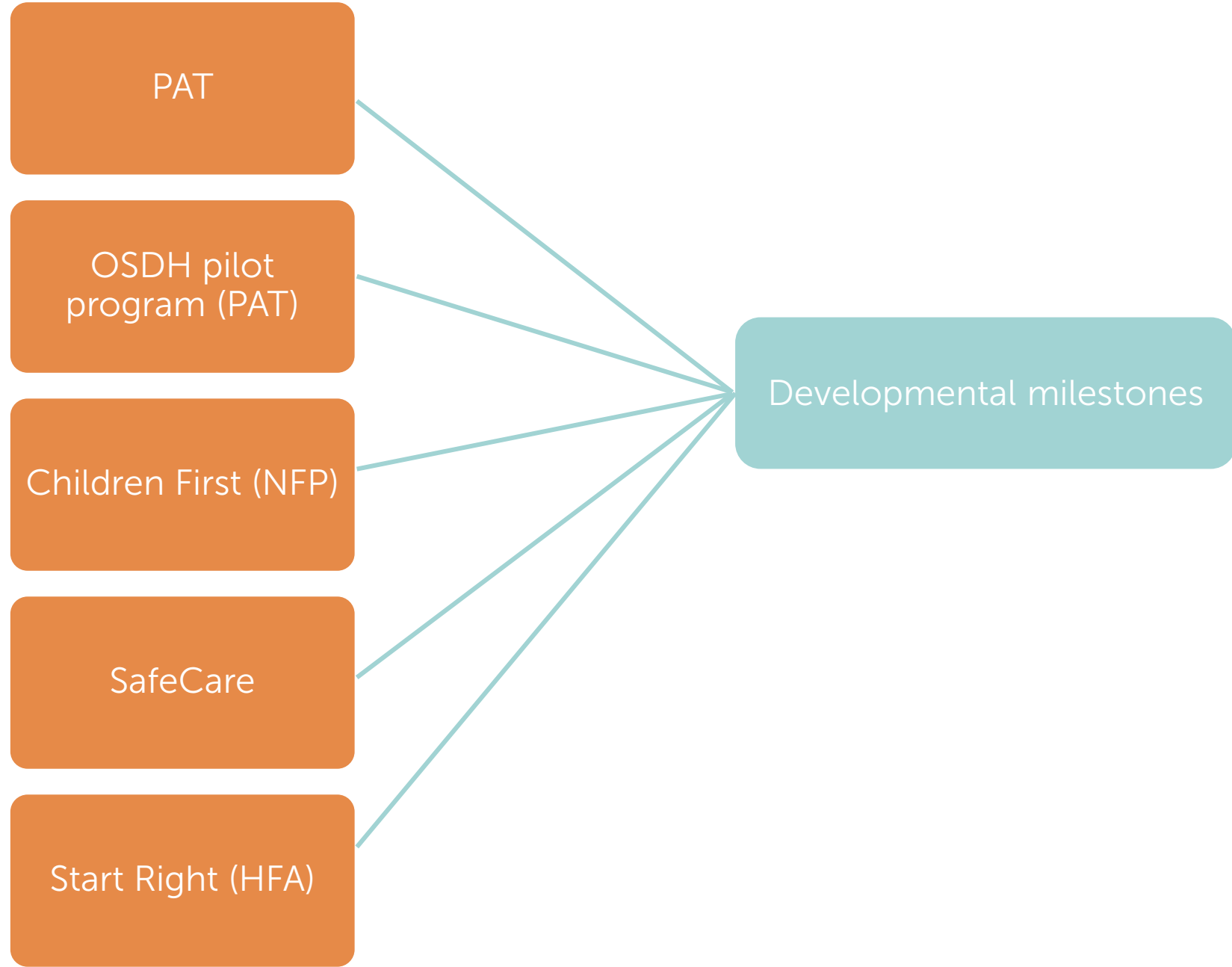
